Weed Control

Extraction of weeds during the summer months.

Waterfowl Management

Water Quality

Help with the implementation and removal of char bags and char bag cages.

Collection of water samples for weekly testing.

Water Safety

Help with the implementation and removal of hazard and safety buoys.

Help with the removal of deadhead trees and stumps from lake.

Help with clearance of trees to increase visibility and waterflow in channel.
